- Logbook Sculling/Basic Membership: Season Fee \$190

Logbook Sculling provides uncoached, independent use of club boats and equipment. \$190 basic membership fee is covered by this cost. Participants must have their captains test and updated swim form on file. Volunteer hours (10 each calendar year) are required.

Seasons:

Spring: April 17th-June 23rd
Summer: June 26th-September 1st
Fall: September 4th-November 10th

- Adult Recreational Rowing: Season Fee \$350

Adult Recreational Rowing provides on the water coaching to those who have rowing experience but do not wish to compete. Participants must have prior rowing experience or at least have taken a learn to row session. \$190 basic membership fee and equipment fee is covered by this cost as well as logbook sculling if you have passed a captain's test. Volunteer hours (10 each calendar year) are required.

Seasons:

Spring: April 3rd-June 9th
Summer: June 12th-August 18th
Fall: August 21st-November 10th

- Masters Competitive Sweep: Season Fee \$1500

Masters Competitive Sweep provides on the water coaching to those who have rowing experience and want to compete. Participants must have prior rowing experience. \$190 basic membership fee, equipment fee, and racing fees are covered by this cost as well as logbook sculling if you have passed a captain's test. Volunteer hours (10 each calendar year) are required.

Season runs March 6th-November 10th

Your basic membership fee (included in all programs except learn to row) entitles you to:

- Use of club equipment (including ergometers and weights)
- Parking lot
- Use of backyard and docking system
- Seasonal membership
- Use of building during operational hours

Mandatory Volunteer Hours:

Your membership requires 10 hours of community service per calendar year. Anyone signed up in a program (excluding learn to row) will be required to complete these hours or it may jeopardize your acceptance into the program the following year. There are plenty of volunteer hours available throughout the year. You will receive emails from the rowing director as these opportunities approach. It is your responsibility to track your hours and turn them in to the director or your coach in order to receive credit for them.
